Sec. 1. Membership to Wolferts Roost Country Club shall not be limited by race, creed, color, sex or national origin.

Membership Classifications

- Sec. 1. The membership of the Club shall consist of such classes of members as are established from time to time by the Goard of Governors by a two-thirds vote of the entire Board.
- Sec. 2. A member is a member of a class designated as a classification at the time of its creation by the Board. Any existing member of a classification preceding the adoption of these By-laws shall remain a member of such class for so long as he or she shall remain a member of that class. Only members or their spouse of a class possessing voting rights may vote for officers or members of the Board of Governors, or hold any of these offices, with each membership having one vote.
- Sec. 3. The membership of this Club shall be limited as directed by the Board of Governors.
- Sec. 4. The Board of Governors may at their discretion extend the privileges of the Club to the surviving spouse of a deceased member for a period not exceeding one (1) year from the date to which the member has paid their dues, providing however, that the spouse of such deceased member may, on his or her request be made a member without being required to pay any intiation fee, upon paying or contracting to pay the dues and fees as established by the Board of Governors.
- Sec. 5. Resident Family Members are those who have a place of residence within one-hundred miles of the City of Albany. Resident Family Members shall have all the privileges of the Club for the member and all members of the family, residing with such member, but excluding members of such family over 25 years of age. Only Resident Family or Senior members may propose or second the application of any individual for membership in Wolferts Roost.
- Sec. 6. Resident Individual Members are those who have a place of residence within one hundred miles of the City of Albany. Resident Individual Members shall have all the privileges of the Club for one member and all other members of the family residing with such member, will have all privileges except for the use of the golf course and the golf practice facilities. Excludes members of such family over 25 years of age.
- Sec. 7. Non-Resident members are those not having a place of residence within one-hundred miles of the City of Albany.
- Sec. 8. A Life Member shall be any member so designated by the Board of Governors. No Life Member so designated shall be obligated to pay dues, but such waiver of dues shall not exempt such member from the payment of such fees or assessments as established by the Board from time to time.
- Sec. 9. Clerical members are any duly ordained members of a religious denomination organized under the Religious Corporations Law of the Sate of New York having a dedicated place of worship within 10 miles of the Club property. They shall have privileges of the Club, except those of holding office or voting.
- Sec. 10. Junior Membership shall be any member, between the ages of 25 and 40. They shall have the privileges of the Club except those of holding office or voting.
- Sec. 11. Non-Resident Members shall be entitled to the privileges as delineated by the Board and such privileges shall extend to the members of the immediate family residing with such Non-Resident member, except this shall not include members of such family over twenty-five (25) years of age.
- Sec. 12. Senior Membership. A Resident Member, who is sixty-five (65) years of age or over and who has been a member in good standing for the immediately preceding twenty (20) years, including any period during which such member has maintained a Non-Resident membership and excluding any period during which such member has been granted a Leave Of Absence, may be granted Senior Membership by the Board of Governors.
- Sec. 13. Legacy Membership. Children of members in good standing or deceased members in good standing at the time of death may apply for membership with a waiver of the initiation fee. Child is defined as a child, or a child by marriage of a current or deceased member.
- Sec. 14. Social Membership shall have all the privileges of the Club except for the use of the golf course and the golf practice facilities. The privileges of the Club shall be extended to the Social Member and all members of the Social Member's family residing with such Social Member, but excluding members of the family having attained the age of 25 years. The Social Member shall not be entitled to be a Life Member, a member of the Board of Governors or a Club Officer and shall not have voting privileges.
- Sec. 15. Corporate Membership. A minimum of four (4) Resident Family Members who shall have all the privileges of the Club for the member and all members of the family, residing with such member, but excluding members of such family over 25 years of age. All members must be employed by the same incorporated business. Corporate Membership shall have one designee who is eligible to vote and make decisions for the membership.

Membership Classification (continued)

Sec. 16. The Membership Committee, with the approval of a two-thirds majority of the full Board of Governors, shall have the authority to offer such membership incentives as the Board shall deem appropriate upon the recommendation of the Membership Committee.

Instructions

- 1) Application for a new member must be obtained from an existing member.
- 2) A complete application must be signed by:
 - a. The applicant, and
 - b. the two proposers.
- 3) The following must be attached to the application:
 - a. Two letters of character from the candidates references,
 - b. a down payment of the initiation fee,
- 4) The application will be presented to the Secretary and the Membership Committee and recorded at the next Board of Governors meeting. A photocopy of this application will be posted on the membership bulletin board until voted upon. The applicant must also meet with the Membership Committee and upon satisfactorily completing all of the above, the application will be presented.
